First Week Details

- **Grade 1 to 6 First Day:** Students will attend for a short two-hour session. Dismissal will be at 10:45 AM. Please make sure your children bring a snack.
- **Opening Week Groupings:** Students will initially return to their previous classroom groupings. Students new to the school community will be placed in a grade-appropriate classroom. Mornings (Wednesday to Friday) will be spent with last year's classes, and afternoons will feature multi-age centers while we finalize enrollment numbers and create official classes.
- **Kindergarten First Day:** The first day for Kindergarten is Wednesday, September 16th, which will be a full day of school. Kindergarten teachers will call families and set up small group visits prior to the start of Kindergarten.
